#### **Dufferin Community Foundation**

We are the forever fund for Dufferin County.

We invest donor gifts into permanent funds and use the income earned to give grants to charities every year... forever!

We are 100% local. All the grant monies go to charities and "qualified donees" that serve residents of Dufferin County.





#### What is a "Qualified Donee"?

Under the Income Tax Act, it is an organization that can issue official donation receipts. This includes registered charities, municipalities and some associations.

Our Articles of Incorporation specify that we can <u>only</u> directly fund qualified donees.

However, nonprofit groups can partner with a charity to receive funding for a collaborative project. (And the legislation is changing...)



#### Supporting your work

In our first five years, we have granted more than \$600,000 via 69 grants to local charities and qualified donees.

This includes federal and corporate funding that we have been entrusted to distribute in Dufferin County, i.e. the Community Services Recovery Fund.

Why a dedicated source of local funding is important to the sustainability of your work in Dufferin County.



#### Our goal

Fund building:

\$10 million in our first 10 years

Community grants:

= \$400,000 every year for local charities





#### Where we are today

Fund building:

**\$2.5** million in our first 5 years

Community grants:

**\$35,000** for 2022 **\$54,000** for 2023

















#### **Types of Funds**

**Donor-Advised Funds** - donor agreement establishes broad strokes of how the annual income will be disbursed and provides yearly advice, informed by the Foundation.


**Field of Interest Funds** - Environment Fund, Arts & Culture Fund, Dufferin Emergency Support Fund, Refugee Resettlement Fund. Donors can establish these funds.

Community Funds - Shelburne Fund, Mulmur Fund

Organization Funds - like the Big Brothers Big Sisters Charitable Endowment Fund






### The Benefits of an Organization Fund

- Charities can create a permanent endowed fund with the Dufferin Community Foundation.
- Once your fund has built to a min. of \$25,000 and been invested for one year, it will be an ongoing, reliable source of revenue for that will last forever.
- The annual earned income would go directly to fund your programs and operations.





### Why Create an Organization Fund?

- Build large fund without contravening CRA rules
- Higher average returns than investing in GICs
- Professional investment and administration
- Having an endowment helps attract major gifts, bequests and legacy gifts.

- focus on fostering diversity, equity and inclusion through arts and culture in Dufferin County

- 1x \$3,000 grant
