DSO Central West Region is administered by Sunbeam Community and Developmental Services

Developmental Services Ontario

Assists adults with a confirmed developmental disability (18 and over) to apply for MCCSS funded developmental services and supports in their community

Confirms eligibility, gathers information for support needs, maintains relevant file information, completes referrals to registries



When to Apply for Developmental Services

A person can start the eligibility process at age 16 If eligible, The
Application for
Developmental
Services and
Supports (ADSS) and
Supports Intensity
Scale (SIS-A) can be
completed at 17.10
or older


Referral for services can be made at age 18








Once Confirmed Eligible: DSO's will...

- Schedule two meetings
- Complete the application: ADSS
- Completion of the Supports Intensity Scale: SIS-A
- Prepare an Assessor Summary Report (ASR) which is a profile, based upon the information that has been shared
- Make referrals based on support needs discussed

Services and Supports



Passport Funding

An eligible person can apply for \$5.5K of Passport funding once they have reached their 18th birthday

Once a person completes their DSO application package, this will be provided to Passport for consideration for additional funds

Housing Supports

Group Living

- Individual lives with a few unrelated people
- Is provided with support for up to 24 hours per day

Supported Independent Living

- Individual lives more independently
- Typically receives <u>between 2 to 10 hours of support</u> each week
- Individual must be able to safely stay alone overnight

Family Home

- Individual lives with a family who can provide supports
- Is matched with a family that has similar interests, needs and lifestyle

The Process in Review

Intake:

Completed by Intake Coordinator

Application Package:

Completed by
Assessor.
The adult application
is compromised of two
meetings that happen
within two weeks of
each other

Referral to Services:

Based on requests and information gathered during meetings

Keep Record up to date:

Inform us of any changes in contact information, changes in individual's needs or caregiver's ability to provide care
